## CALLERLAB

CALLERLAB is revising lists for the Mainstream and Plus Programs.

The Plus lists reflect some major changes. Several Quarterly Selections were added to the Plus I list and two Plus II calls were moved to the Plus I list. The end result is that the Plus I list is now 17 calls long. CALLERLAB members voted to drop three calls from the Plus II list in addition to the calls moved to the Plus I list. Swap Around, Curley Cross, and All Eight Swing Thru have been dropped from the Plus II list. Grand Swing Thru and <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Tag the Line have been added. It is anticipated that the two lists will be combined at the CALLERLAB Convention in 1982.

Please also note that the Mainstream list has been frozen for a period of three years. Additions to the Mainstream list can only be made to the list in the calls 49-68 area and only if the calls recommended meet the eligibility requirements of having been on the QS list for a period of three years.

CALLERLAB feels that this stability will benefit square dancers all over the world and we hope that all clubs and callers support this new designation.

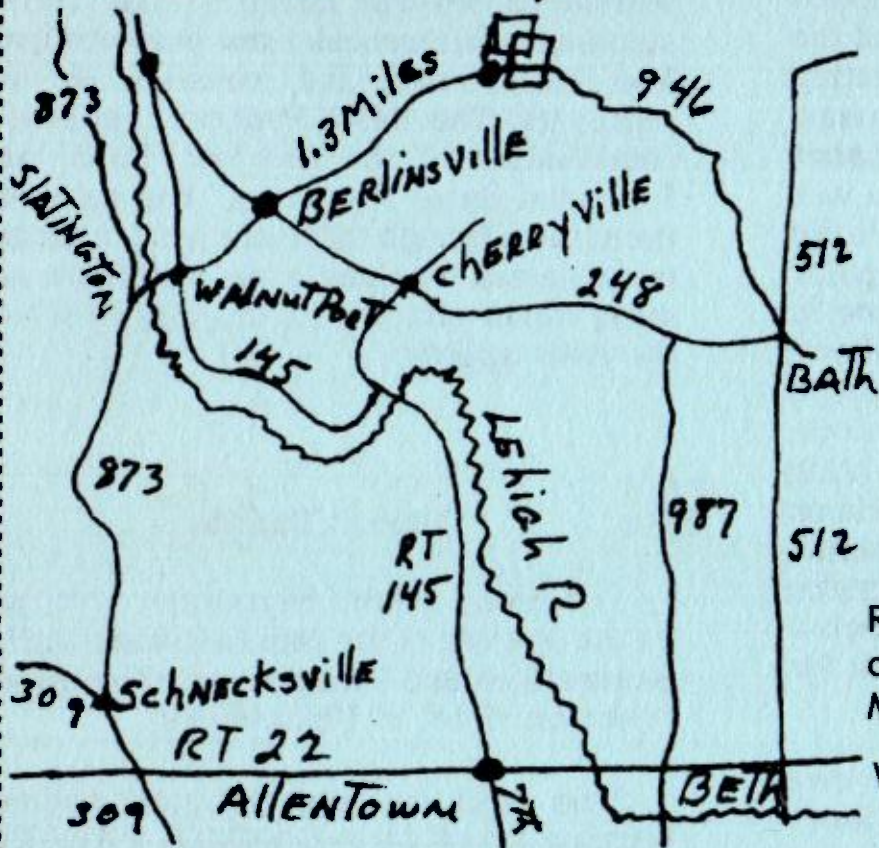
