DO YOU KNOW

That there are four districts in the Delaware Valley Square and Round Dance Federation — also known as DVSRDF?

The Federation holds five meetings a year to further Square and Round Dancing. Our District (Mid-East Penn) is represented by five couples that help to plan the activities for the Federation. You as a Federation Member have a right to attend these meetings. The Annual Convention of Square & Round Dancers held at the Sheraton Hotel in Philadelphia each September is planned by a committee of about 200 people working for a period of two years. This is the big event of the DVSRDF each year.

The Free Dances held each summer that are planned by our district so that new graduates can meet and dance with other graduates as well as experienced dancers from other clubs, are financed by the Federation. A current Federation Membership Card is your ticket to these dances.

The Federation publishes the "Where to Dance" books every other year and provides them free. They also have the Coordinator printed and distributed. The Basic Books of Square Dancing as well as all Square and Round Dance Diplomas are furnished by the DVSRDF.
