

33rd NATIONAL SQUARE DANCE CONVENTION

Many Square Dancers have admired the 33rd National Square Dance Convention logo as seen on the convention staff badges. They have also asked for an explanation of its meaning. The overall concept combines landmarks of Balitmore with Square Dance symbols. Square dancing is represented by the two dancers and the musical staff. The staff also reminds us of the Star Spangled Banner, whose history is so intertwined with that of Baltimore, as well as bringing to mind George M. Cohan's, "It's a Grand Old Flag," the convention theme.

As you look at the logo imagine yourself standing on the deck of the "Pride of Baltimore" sailing around the Inner Harbor. Looking from left to right you will

see the following buildings:

First, a collection of buildings typical of

the downtown area.

Next, the dome of the Administration Building of the John Hopkins Hospital, a world-famous research and teaching institution.

Then you see the top of the Maryland National Bank Building, a prominent feature of the Baltimore skyline because of the flashing lights which spell MN.

Beside the bank building is the Bromo-Seltzer Tower. On each of its four sides is a clock face using the letters of the trade name Bromo-Seltzer as well as numerals to mark the hours.

The Washington Monument at Mt. Vernon Place comes next. It is a memorial to our country's first President and is situated in an elegant residential area just

north of downtown.

The roundhouse next to the Washington Monument is part of the Transportation Museum, sure to attract many convention visitors. In front of the roundhouse, but not pictured on the logo, is Mt. Clare Station, the oldest railroad station in the world.

You move now to the World Trade Center at the Inner Harbor. Visitors to this building who make the trip to its 27th floor will be rewarded with a panoramic view of Baltimore.

Finally, look at the dome of the Baltimore City Hall, a post-Civil War building recently restored to reflect its

original splendor.

There you have it, Baltimore's essence captured by a blue and white logo. We hope you feel a thrill of pride whenever you see it used. See you at the Convention in 1984.

but no action will be taken without the required number of co-sponsors on HJR No. 151.
