LETTER TO THE EDITOR

Dot and Cliff,

As you may know, my beloved wife Mimi died on August 18 after a two week fight with a very rapidly moving cancer. She had just received her masters degree in Aging and Health from Lehigh on June 5 (also our 1st anniversary) Mimi was ahead of her time in believing that the elderly were one of our greatest untapped natural resources. Her entire schooling was aimed at preparing to provide counciling for elderly and their families to adjust to their retirement and declining abilities. She felt that the preparation should begin well before retirement. She was also a strong proponent of the need for family support during recovery from major diseases and had started work with stroke victims. She was a regular face at many nursing homes as the person who popped into visit those who had no visitors. Her proposed work with the elderly will be picked up by several local clergy and a fund has been set up to assist them in obtaining the needed resource materials. The Wise Old Owl told me to be very patient with the new dancer because you were once one yourself but pass on to all your dancers some of the tips and pointers you have picked up over the years. As we all know that owl is wise and cannot be fooled too often.

Over a period of fifteen years of dancing — three years as a Solo and twelve years with my Husband — I have picked up some tips and pointers. The individual people told me these in a different form but it all comes out the same.

I would like to mention the individuals only because I recall the years of dancing and growing, not only to respect these three, but to love and admire them.

The caller that taught me, Chick Stone, because of his understanding ways as well as his wife, Doris; the man who was and still is an Angel, Harris Brown, because of his style of dancing. Third is a well-known National Caller — Jack Lasry of whom I can't say enough — he is just someone special. Understand all of the rest of my Dancing Buddies and Friends are special but these three are just a little more special to me as well as my husband.

Let's get down to some facts that we hope will help the new as well as the old dancers.

First — leave all your troubles of the day at home or outside so that you can pick them up after the dance. Come to the dance to relax and have fun. Maybe your problems aren't as bad as they seem and it may interfer with your thinking for dancing.

Second—listen to the caller and cuer—if you break down, don't argue with your partner and other dancers—wait until after the tip and work it out if it is a new figure. Perhaps someone in the square who has been dancing longer will help you or go to the caller—he or she are always willing to help. After all, we all make mistakes, I make my share, sometimes I can recover and sometimes I can't.

This brings up a third item — know the figure but don't be ashamed to admit you don't know or don't remember. As I said before we all make mistakes. So just square up amd wait for a more formal call and start from there, or if you can form lines-pair off.

Fourth is Styling. Know where you belong which also goes to the figure knowledge. If you know where you belong—the errors are very few. Let other dancers guide you, especially if they seem to know what they are doing. The fifth and (Continued On Page 26)




