## DISTRICT MEETING REVIEW

Mid-East Penn District opened their May '84 meeting at 5 p.m. with a prayer and pledge. Minutes were approved as mailed to the clubs. Charlie Watters reported \$2623.30 in checking and savings.

\$1567.75 was raised for The Friends of the Handicapped. Forty graduates joined the Federation bringing our membership to 1090.

Preparations are well under way for the three summer dances and the picnic. We elected John and Kathy Falter, Howard and Joan Gluckman, Joe and Betty Mathers, and Bill and Irma Molin as delegates and Russ and Shirley Benner and Bill and Joann Harding as alternates to the Federation Board of directors.

We agreed that Squares and Rounds would be an even better paper than it already is, if clubs would send more detailed articles on their activities. District delegates voted unanimously to send the Federation Presidents a letter condemning pricing policies for entries in the proposed new Where to Dance book and recommended that callers, cuers, and clubs employ other advertising sources. Delegates voted overwhelmingly to hold a benefit dance, featuring local callers and cuers on a second, fourth, or fifth Sunday to support special district projects. The meeting was adjourned shortly after 5:30.

#### TEXAS BAKED EGGS

- 3 dozen Eggs
- 1/2 Cup Milk
- 1/2 Cup Margarine
- 1 medium Onion, diced
- 1 medium green or red Pepper, diced
- 1 lb. sausage, pork or beef
- 2 cans Cream of Mushroom Soup
- 2-3 Tablespoons Sherry (optional)
- 1 lb. Sharp Cheddar Cheese, grated
- 1 can mushrooms

Cook and drain sausage. Scramble eggs with milk, margarine, onion and pepper. (I split eggs, do half at a time, 3 dozen will tire your arms) Mix undiluted Cream of Mushroom soup with Sherry (or 2-3 Tbs. milk) In a deep 3 quart casserole, or 9 X 13" greased baking pan, layer egg sausage, soup, cheese, repeat until all mixture is in casserole. Top with paprika and sauteed mushrooms. REFRIGERATE 8 hours or overnight. Bake 50 minutes at 300°.

Delicious, add juice, hash browned potatoes, crispy french bread and fruit. This will give everyone enough energy to last the afternoon Horseshoes, jarts, baseball, cycling and you name it coming up!!

Have you added a sandwich maker to your camping equipment? If not, now's the time! We are looking forward to pizzas and fruit pies around the after dance campfire and eggs and toast done at once in the morning.

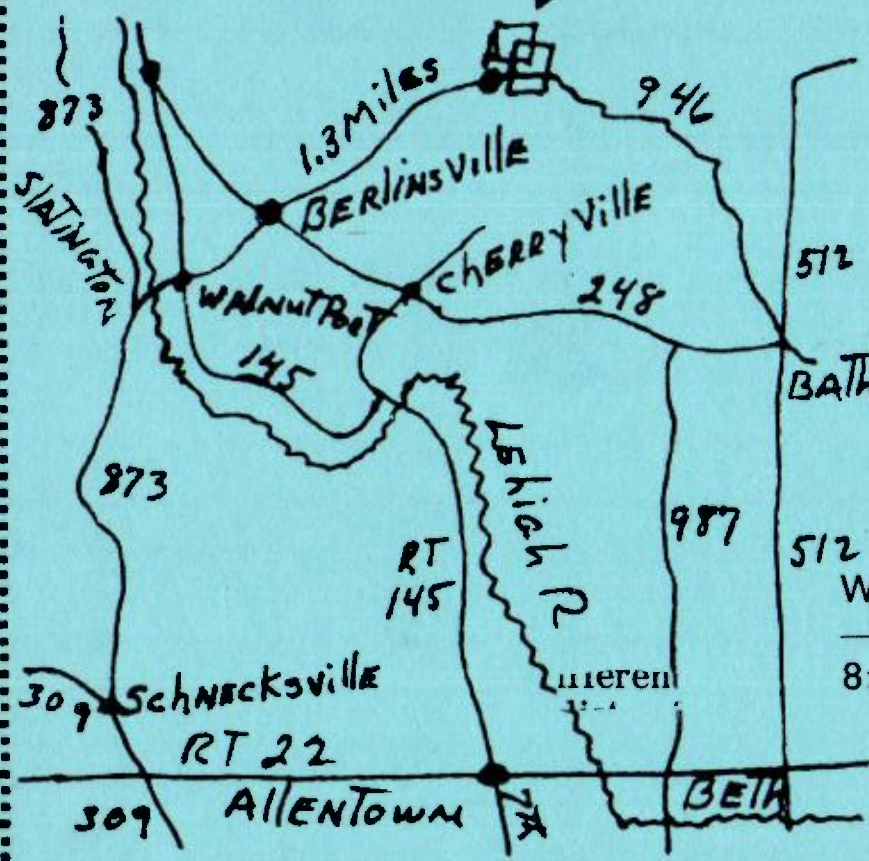
