"MORE NOSTAGLIA"

The publication-Montgomery District for the Square Dancers was originally a legal size sheet of paper folded in three sections. The first edition of Squares & Rounds (as it is now known) was a total of eight pages. There were 27 active Clubs at that time. We now have 44 active Clubs in our District — we really have grown, haven't we? The name Montgomery District was the original name but it was felt that the name was not accurate because of so many Clubs outside of Montgomery County.

A committee appointed by the Chairman, Walt Henderson arrived at the name Mid-East Penn District. It was changed at a meeting in June, 1977.

Since Folk Dancing and patchwork share a common heritage with our country, it would be fitting to utilize this needlecraft in designing a square dance dress. This seems especially appropriate now that we're hoping to have Square Dancing named the National Folk Dance of the U.S.A.

Patchwork is an American folk art. While patches are nothing new, true patchwork as an art was invented by the women of America. It's origin was extreme poverty. The women who created this needlework didn't have a penny to spend or a 1/2 inch bit of cloth to waste and yet they wanted to add beauty to the functional articles that they painstakingly made by hand.

There were two developments in American patchwork, "Geometricals" and Applique. In the geometricals, which as the earliest, these seams are almost always straight. Later the American became more prosperous and could spare bits of fabric merely for ornament, the women cut out curved pieces, laid them on cloth and hemmed down their turned under edges. Because applique is not limited to straight seams, the patterns are less symbolic and more naturalistic. This technique lends itself to graceful curves of flowers and foliage, and the natural shape of butterflies, birds and animals and even figures of people, houses, etc. To learn more about patchwork, the many patterns, and how they developed, you will want to visit libraries and museums as we couldn't begin to tell the fascinating stories of patchwork here. Instead let me suggest a few ways that you might use patchwork in a square dance dress, skirt, vest or yoke on a man's shirt.

While our great-grandmothers cut good pieces from worn out clothing or household articles for their patchwork, most of us have access to many pieces of new fabric left from our sewing projects, which could be used to create lovely patchwork. Or we can follow the example of the thrifty inventors of patchwork and use portions of garments we will never wear again.

The simplest patchwork is made of squares or rectangles of fabric pieced together. Since true patchwork is designed, you will want to consider color,

design and size of prints as you plan the arrangement of your patches. Such patchwork can be made into a skirt or vest, alone or in combination with a solid color. Strips of such patchwork make attractive ruffles, borders or inserts. Some traditional quilt patterns such as Dresden Plate and Rising Sun or Star patterns can be used very effectively. One especially attractive square dance dress was made of a coordinating color of plain and checked gingham. The 8 gore skirt had alternate rows of plain and checked, with a Dresden Plate, pieced in harmonizing prints, appliqued to each plain gore.

Also seen on the dance floor have been pretty skirts decorated with appliqued flowers of plain or print fabric or felt. Some needlecrafters have used one spray of large flowers only on the front of the skirt, others have designed smaller bouquets or single flowers to decorate gores or as a border. Rick rack, bias tape or embroidery can be used to represent stems or highlight flowers. You don't have to limit yourself to flowers. Birds, butterflies, animals and scenes are just a few suggestions for applique. Pictures of Friendship and Album quilts will give you ideas for your own design.

Originally patchwork was the expression of its creator, but as time went on, patterns were developed which are still being used today. However many needlecrafters didn't copy the pattern exactly, but added to or modified it, so feel free to do the same. You can be as creative as you choose.


If you prefer to have help designing your patchwork, the fabric stores have much to offer. Quilt patterns and stencils are available; craft sections of the pattern books have patterns for appliques fabric with quilt patterns printed on them can be purchased by the panel; some fabrics have large enough flowers, butterflies, etc., in the design that can be cut out and appliqued on your garment. While all the patchwork was originally done by hand, much of it can now be done on the machine, even applique by using a zig-zag stitch. From experience I've found it advisable to secure the design with stitch witchery or a similar product before beginning to stitch. When appliqueing small designs by machine it's easier to stitch first and then complete the cutting, being careful not to cut the stitching.
