Between 1976 and 1977, the officers of the Federation reviewed the past conventions regarding the attendance and popularity and it was decided to continue them but they had to be held in a different place.

After months of looking at several hotels and their facilities, it was decided to hold them at the Sheraton that is now The Philadelphia Centre Hotel. This Hotel was chosen not only for all their facilities but for the central location for all the dancers from New Jersey, Delaware and Pennsylvania.

Both Sam and I have attended many of these conventions since we began to dance. We attend these conventions for three reasons: 1) To support the Federation. 2) To meet new people and renew old friendship. 3) For the fun.
