

NEW JERSEY SQUARE DANCE COUNCIL ANNOUNCES 2ND ANNUAL STATE CONVENTION

Square Dance Council of New Jersey

The Square Dance Council of New Jersey announces the 2nd Annual New Jersey State Square and Round Dance Convention, to be held on March 19, 1988. Trenton State College in Ewing Township, a central location with many excellent facilities — including ample parking, will again host the Convention.

Last year, over 1,700 delegates participated in the first convention, and more than 2,500 are expected to register for 1988. While most attendees were from New Jersey, dancers from as far north as New England and as far south as Virginia were among the happy crowd. To accom-

modate the additional delegates expected, a total of six halls will be available for convention activities.

There will be continuous dancing from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. which will include square dancing ranging from Basic through Challenge. And, in response to suggestions from last year, the Advanced and Challenge programs will be increased. A full program of round dancing in all phases is also scheduled along with time set aside for clogging, contra dancing, mixers, line dancing and folk dancing. A Grand March will take place at 7:00 p.m.

Once again, several educational and leadership seminars, including a sewing clinic, will be held. And, special areas have been reserved for vendors and exhibitors. A Showcase of Ideas will feature displays by area dance organizations. Clubs and organizations are encouraged to bring their banners, which will be displayed in the registration area.

Callers, cuers, promptors and dance leaders from New Jersey and surrounding areas may be programmed for the convention if they register before December 31, 1987 and indicate their interest on the application.

For the delegates' convenience, additional space has been reserved this year for those wishing to bring recreational vehicles. The campus has a snack bar and restaurant, which will be open for most of the day, and many reasonably priced restaurants and fast-food establishments are only a short drive away. There are also several hotels and motels





val throughout the square dance world. The best part of the deal is that they are free for the asking.

The folders, printed in black and red, are not primarily designed for promotion and recruitment, but rather for interpretation and retention of new dancers as classes start. Callers and square dance club leaders are urged to order a quantity of them to hand out this fall.

In effect, the easy-to-read script says "this is what square dancing today is all about." Reference is made to some of the major organizations, such as Callerlab, Roundalab and Legacy. Other topics, briefly discussed, are Heritage, Etiquette, Apparel, Visitation, Publications, Festivals and Glossary. There's a place on the folder to localize key information.

Just one of the concise paragraphs, under the heading of Apparel, reads as follows:

"Our colorful apparel identifies us as square dancers. Proper attire at dances

is very important. Men should wear long sleeve western-style shirts and neckwear. Women should wear a dress or a skirt and blouse with a petticoat. Look special! Feel special! Be special!"

NOSTALGIA

The publication, Montgomery District for the Square Dancers, was originally a legal size sheet of paper folded in 3 sections. The first edition of Squares and Rounds (as it is now known) was a total of 8 pages. There were 27 active clubs at that time. We now have 40 clubs in our district — we have really grown. The



Be sure to cut your facing to match the neckline design by using the bodice pattern as a guide.


